
# **Pre-Event Role-Specific Information - Volunteer Coordinators**

Your volunteer coordinator is your go-to resource for anything related to your volunteer position. If you were assigned a volunteer role before the event, you should receive an email before the event from your volunteer coordinator with their contact information and details about your volunteer role. If you have completed the application to volunteer, you can message your volunteer coordinator before the event through your *FIRST* dashboard at <a href="https://my.firstinspires.org/Dashboard/">https://my.firstinspires.org/Dashboard/</a>

Under Pending Applications in the Volunteer Registration tab in your *FIRST* dashboard, find the Role Options button and select "Message Coordinator" from the drop-down menu. This option is also available under your Assigned Event Roles. (See screenshots below.)

# **Volunteer Registration and Badging**

### Check-in

Volunteers must go to the Volunteer Registration desk on Level One (see map in *FIRST* Championship Volunteer Orientation) to get their name badge when they first arrive at the event. Volunteers over the age of 16 who were not assigned roles before the event can sign up as walk-on volunteers at the Information Booth near the Registration Desk.

FIRST requires every Championship attendee to be registered and badged, including adult team mentors, youth team members, parents, family members, chaperones, etc. who are participating in the event. Attendee registration grants access to participant-only activities and increases the security of the event.

# Name Badging

If you were assigned before the event, you should have received an email to RSVP for the event and register with *FIRST* Championship Registration. Completing this registration includes confirming the days you will be volunteering, submitting



any special dietary needs, and giving your T-shirt size. If you registered with *FIRST* Championship Registration, please take the following steps:

- Print your personalized barcode found in the confirmation email from *FIRST* Championship Registration and bring it with you or pull up the email on your smartphone to be scanned.
- Bring a form of photo identification.
- Scan the barcode and staff will prepare your badge at the Volunteer Registration desk.
- If you are under the age of 16, bring the responsible adult who will be monitoring you to the Volunteer Registration desk when picking up your name badge.

If you did not register with *FIRST* Championship Registration before arriving but have been assigned to a volunteer position:

- Bring a form of photo identification.
- Print your assignment email or be able to pull it up on a smartphone.
- Register and confirm your information with staff onsite at the Volunteer Registration desk to receive your name badge.

If you have not received an email from *FIRST* Championship registration but have been assigned to a volunteer position, please email volunteer@firstinspires.org to receive the registration email.

# **Event Registration Categories**

For those who have attended Championship before, you will notice a few changes to the layout and our registration categories. To accommodate the increased number of teams, the Hospitality Center on Level Two is now the Innovation Faire. There is no longer a large Hospitality Center. We also no longer have a broad registration category for Special Invited Guests or VIPs with an associated hospitality lounge. Instead, each of our primary stakeholder groups (i.e. sponsors, volunteers, staff, etc.) will receive similar amenities such as dedicated spaces to relax with food and beverage offerings.

As our largest (and most important) stakeholder group, volunteers will continue to gather at Volunteer Central where we will have the most robust food offerings as well as fun prizes, raffles, and giveaways!

#### Consent and Release Forms

All volunteers must complete a current season FIRST Consent and Release form.

#### Walk-On Volunteers

Walk-on volunteers must be 16 years or older. QR Codes will be available for you to scan to complete a form with your availability and area(s) of interest. Once the form is completed, there will be a wait time to receive your assignment, so please be patient. A Volunteer Coordinator will contact you by phone call or text (international numbers will be contacted by email) with assignment details. Once you are assigned a volunteer role, the central registration desk will assist you in upgrading your credentials to 'volunteer.' People interested in the Student Ambassador role should not complete this process and should visit the Student Ambassador booth across from Central Registration.

#### **Attire**

Please dress in comfortable, appropriate attire that will allow you to carry out your volunteer role safely. Closed-toe shoes are required. We suggest choosing supportive footwear. You will be provided with a volunteer shirt and name badge to wear during your shift. Keep your name badge with you throughout the event as it is required to enter certain areas. Teams may be decked out in team uniforms or other fun attire to show their spirit. Volunteers are welcome to join in the fun and bring a silly hat or other fun accessories. Keep safety in mind and avoid dangling or loose items. All attire should reflect Gracious Professionalism.

# **Safety Glasses**

Safety Glasses are required in some areas of the venue and for some volunteer roles. *FIRST* Robotics Competition and *FIRST* Tech Challenge programs require that everyone wear safety glasses in the pit and field areas. It is recommended that you bring your own safety glasses or protective side shields for prescription glasses to ensure fit, cleanliness, and ability to move freely throughout the venue.

# Volunteer Arrival & Parking

# **Early Entrance**

The Hilton Skybridge on Level Three opens at 5:30 AM. The Marriott Skybridge and street entrances to GRB open at 6:00 AM.

### Volunteer Parking

The GRB Convention Center has limited Volunteer parking available for 2023 due to construction. The Volunteer parking is located at the GRB Convention Center loading dock off Chartres. Drivers should enter the loading dock gates by taking a left into the open gate across from Walker St. off Chartres. A map of the parking lot for volunteers will be available in the *FIRST* Championship Volunteer Orientation presentation and in the posted slides which will be available on the Volunteer page of the Championship website.

Volunteer Parking passes will be emailed to volunteers by Volunteer Coordinators. Parking is first come, first served.

Please note the following:

- From Monday to Saturday of Championship week the lot will be open from 5:30 AM and close at 10 PM.
- Overnight parking is not permitted.
- There is no code to enter the lot.
- There is no security. The lot is not connected to the GRB convention center. After parking, you will enter the Convention Center through a street or skybridge entrance.
- Park at your own risk.
- Your Volunteer Coordinator will email you a parking pass which is required to access the lot. Please print it in advance and make sure it is visible on your car's dashboard.
- Free parking options are limited. This lot's availability is first come, first served. Parking may fill up quickly in the morning.
- You may park in any available open spot in the lot.
- This lot is utilized by events staff and volunteers.
- Other than parking permission the pass is also important so that volunteers can circumvent the lanes being utilized by teams for the load in and load.
- Do not park along the loading docks.



- Do not park trailers in the Volunteer Parking lot, this takes additional parking spaces away from other volunteers. Trailers are NOT permitted in this lot.
- Buses are not permitted in this parking lot.

#### **Volunteer Food**

When you registered for Championship, you registered for the meals you planned to eat in the Volunteer Café. You are welcome to eat on the days you are volunteering. To accommodate our record-breaking numbers of volunteers in 2023, we ask for your *Gracious Professionalism* and eat elsewhere on days you are not volunteering. *FIRST* is charged for each meal that a volunteer registers for regardless of whether you come to the Café for that meal. Therefore, it is incredibly important to only register for those meals you plan to eat on the days you volunteer. We understand schedules and plans change. We want to remind you that you can go back into your event registration and change your meal selections up to the day before the meal. Meal numbers are pulled from the system each day. Thank you for working with us to ensure we keep costs down and food waste to a minimum.

The Volunteer Café is in Room 370. Additional seating will be in Room 371 as well as the prefunction space at the front of the main hallway. Meals are provided to volunteers on the day of their shift. Meals will be served in Dine-In or in Grab-N-Go containers. You are welcome to sit and eat in the Volunteer café, sit in the overflow seating Room 371, sit in the prefunction hallway space, or take your meal elsewhere. During lunch, outdoor seating is available for volunteers on Balcony D. To access Balcony D, go down the escalator to Level Two as you leave Volunteer Central and Balcony D is directly adjacent to where you depart the escalator.

#### Snacks

In addition to the main meals in the Volunteer Café snacks will be delivered to Pit Admins twice a day. - Food items will be marked with allergen and other ingredient info when available.
- If you have questions about ingredients or where to find various food options, please see the Volunteer Café Representative at the Special Dietary Needs table.
- Kosher and halal meals are not kept on the Special Dietary Needs table, so please speak to the Volunteer Café
  representative to receive your meal.
- If you did not register your request in advance, we may not be able to accommodate your request.

# Reporting Medical Incidents and Youth Protection Concerns

If you need to report to a Youth Protection concern that is not an emergency you can report these concerns using the <u>FIRST Reporting Portal</u> or go to the nearest Pit Admin. The <u>FIRST Reporting Portal</u> can be used for any issue related to volunteering, the venue, Code of Conduct, Youth Protection, or other non-emergent safety issues. Please do not use this online form to report an urgent safety issue; follow the Emergency Procedure guidance below.

# Safety

All children under the age of 12 must always be accompanied by an adult while in the Pit area.

Be aware of apparel and hair safety issues while working on your robot. Sandals, open-toed shoes, and Crocs are not allowed in the Pits, fields, or other teamwork areas. Wear relaxed, fun and appropriate clothing; remember, you represent your team and *FIRST*. Body paint in lieu of clothes, bathing suits and other revealing clothes are not appropriate.



### **Emergency Procedures**

For urgent situations, report instantly to the nearest pit admin, *FIRST* staff member, or Volunteer Coordinator. There are medics and security onsite in the venue. They can be radioed by pit admin or staff for immediate assistance.

If the building is being evacuated, please exit the building as directed.

#### When there is risk of major harm:

- Medical tell pit admin, VC (Volunteer Coordinator), staff –they will radio the EMT's /Medic onsite
- Safety issue go to closest pit admin or event staff they will know who to contact

<u>CDC (Centers for Disease Control) guidelines</u> encourage the following preventative actions, which are also applicable to preventing the spread of many viruses:

- Stay home if feeling unwell, developing a cough, or running a fever (Call or message your Volunteer Coordinator if you need to stay home)
- Practice hand hygiene, including frequent hand washing, use of hand sanitizer, and avoiding touching eyes, nose, and mouth (there will be hand sanitizer available throughout the venue)
- Practice respiratory etiquette, including covering cough and sneezes with a tissue, and then disposing of the tissue in the trash
- Clean frequently touched surface and objects daily (including tablets and cell phones)
- Perform self-monitoring, and seek medical care immediately if feeling unwell (You can see a medic available onsite at the event)

#### **COVID Protocol Requirements - Health Safety Guidelines**

- Practice Social Distance, when possible
- Vaccination is strongly recommended, but not required
- If you become ill, please stay in your hotel room/lodging and contact your Volunteer Coordinator.

#### **Safety Equipment**

 Bring your own safety glasses and enough masks for the duration of the event. Masks/face coverings are not required but are recommended.

#### Safety Outside the Venue

- Do not wear your badge outside the venue.
- Be aware of your surroundings.
- Always walk in groups.
- Use main streets and boulevards.
- Whenever possible, avoid walking downtown at night. If you cannot avoid walking downtown at night, pay attention, walk in a group, and get where you are going as fast as possible.

#### Security

Be sure to keep valuable items with you always. FIRST and the George R. Brown Convention Center do not guarantee



security of personal items. We strongly recommend that you do not leave behind valuable items at any time, such as personal computers, cellphones, cameras, etc. You can report any lost items to the Event Information Desk (see Lost and Found).

Remember, the event is open to the public. Please take proper security measures to protect your valuable items.

#### Prohibited Items

- Abusive, foul, or disruptive language
- · Aerosol containers of any kind
- Animals (except service animals to aid guests with disabilities)
- Coolers\*
- Fighting, taunting, threatening remarks, gestures, or harassment of any kind
- Fireworks, firearms, and weapons of any kind (including parking lots)
- · Glass containers of any kind
- Illegal substances, drugs, and drug paraphernalia
- Knives of any length except pocketknives no longer than 4"
- Laser Pointers
- Noisemakers (musical instruments, bullhorns, air horns, whistles, etc.)
- Outside Alcohol/Flasks
- Outside food or beverages\*
- Smoking or the use of vapor (or similar) devices
- Throwing objects
- Trespassing, soliciting, peddling, and loitering
- Unauthorized/unlicensed vendors are not allowed.
- No unauthorized solicitation and materials including handbills, flyers, stickers, giveaways, samples, etc.
- Unmanned Aircraft Systems & Radio-Controlled Model Aircraft/Drones
- Any other item or action deemed dangerous or inappropriate.

Event security reserves the right to deem any other item inappropriate. No prohibited item will be accepted at the entry gates for safekeeping.

\*Exceptions will be made for those with medical requirements and/or special needs. Individuals with these special needs should contact a security person at their entry gate for special attention.







# **Appendix B - Volunteer Minimum Age Policy**

# FIRST Championship Volunteer Minimum Age Policy

Due to the size and scope of the *FIRST* Championship events, the following special guidelines address *FIRST* Championship volunteer minimum age restrictions. The minimum age to volunteer at *FIRST* Championship is 16 except for the specific exceptions listed below by the program.

Youth between the ages of 13 and 15 that wish to volunteer for one of the roles listed below must register and be approved through the Volunteer Registration system prior to the event and be accompanied by a responsible adult.

- FIRST Robotics Competition
  - May accept volunteers 14+ to be Student Ambassadors
- FIRST Tech Challenge
  - May accept volunteers 14+ to be Student Ambassadors
  - May accept volunteers 13+ for the following volunteer roles:
    - Queuer
    - Field Reset
    - Safety Attendant
    - Pit Runner
- FIRST LEGO League Challenge
  - May accept volunteers 15+ for the following volunteer roles:
    - Practice Table Assistants
    - Pit Runners
    - Team Queuer
    - Floater
    - Ceremony Assistant
    - Activities Assistant
- FIRST LEGO League Explore
  - May accept volunteers 15+ for the following volunteer roles:
    - Team Queuer
    - Activities Assistant


This is the registration process for 13-15-year-old volunteers to volunteer at FIRST Championship:

- For the safety of our youth volunteers at Championship, all volunteers age 13-15 must register in advance in our Volunteer Registration system and be accompanied by an adult. Walk-on volunteers must be 16 years or older.
- Apply in the Volunteer Registration system for one of the roles listed above and complete consent and release forms
- When applying for a role in Volunteer Registration, name the responsible adult that will be assigned to monitor and accompany the youth volunteer in the comments section
  - A responsible adult is defined as either a parent or legal guardian or someone 21+ who has written permission from the parent/guardian to act as substitute guardian
  - o A team mentor or coach may also serve as a responsible adult
- On-site at FIRST Championship:
  - 13-15-year-old volunteers must be accompanied by their responsible adult when they check-in at the Volunteer Registration desk and both must provide ID.
  - The responsible adult is responsible for accompanying and monitoring the youth volunteer while they are volunteering on-site at *FIRST* Championship. The responsible adult may accompany the youth as a volunteer in the same area or monitor the volunteering youth from nearby as a non-volunteer.






Sample email invitation from *FIRST* to register as a volunteer.






# Registration Step 1 - Personal Information






# Registration Step 2 - Dietary Information & Meal Selection











# Registration Step 2 - Special Events for Volunteers




