

Pre-Event Role-Specific Information - Volunteer Coordinators

Your volunteer coordinator is your go-to resource for anything related to your volunteer position. When you are assigned a volunteer role, you will receive an email before the event from your volunteer coordinator with the contact information and details about your volunteer role. You can message your volunteer coordinator before the event through your *FIRST* dashboard at https://my.firstinspires.org/Dashboard/.

Under Pending Applications in the Volunteer Registration tab in your *FIRST* dashboard, find the Role Options button and select "Message Coordinator" from the drop-down menu. This option is also available under your Assigned Event Roles. (See screenshots below.)

For *FIRST* Robotics Competition, you can email <u>firstchampionshipvolunteer@firstinspires.org</u>. For *FIRST* Lego League and *FIRST* Tech Challenge, your volunteer coordinator's email will be in your volunteer assignment email.





How to Apply and Register to Volunteer

Follow these steps to apply to Volunteer for *FIRST* Championship. Applications to volunteer for 2025 *FIRST* Championship will no longer be accepted through the dashboard after **April 8**th. Anyone who would like to volunteer and has not applied by **April 8**th, can still volunteer as a walk-on volunteer at the event.

Step 1 - Apply for a Volunteer Role in FIRST Dashboard

- Create an account or Login to your existing FIRST dashboard account.
- Under event volunteering, use the filters (dates: 4.15.25 4.19.25, location: Houston, TX) to find the Championship event for each program or follow one of these links to sign up for a volunteer role in a specific program.
- o FIRST LEGO League Explore FIRST Championship
- FIRST LEGO League Challenge FIRST Championship
- o FIRST Tech Challenge FIRST Championship
- FIRST Robotics Competition FIRST Championship
- Choose the day(s) you wish to volunteer and choose your top five roles.
- You will receive an email notification when your role has been assigned.

Step 2 – Complete any necessary training and certifications

- Complete the current FIRST Consent and Release form in the dashboard.
- All volunteers must complete a current season FIRST Consent and Release form. Volunteers must sign the FIRST Consent & Release Form each season. Volunteers will see a notification if they haven't yet completed the form when they log into the <u>FIRST Dashboard</u> and can access via the profile drop down menu by selecting Acknowledgement Forms.
- Complete the Youth Protection Certification.
- You will not be able to volunteer without completing these items.
- Complete required certifications for any roles requiring training.
- Volunteer Registration User Guide & BlueVolt User Guide

Step 3 - Complete event registration and book your hotel.

• After receiving an email notification that your role has been assigned, you will receive a registration invitation link in your email to register for the event (within 5-7 business days). This registration must be completed prior to attending Championship so you can be badged. All attendees at the event must be badged. See appendix B for a walkthrough of the registration process.



- In this registration form you will select your meal preferences (meals are provided on the days you volunteer) and what additional events you will be attending (to help *FIRST* estimate food amounts). Please make sure this information is accurate so *FIRST* can ensure food is available and ready for those who are volunteering. You can also designate any special dietary restrictions, and this information must be entered prior to **April 1st**.
- You will receive a link in your email to sign up for the *FIRST* hotel block. These provide you with access to the *FIRST* hotel blocks with discounted rates. You are not required to use the *FIRST* hotel block.

On-Site Volunteer Registration and Badging

Check-in

Volunteers must go to the Volunteer Registration Desk on Level One (see map in *FIRST* Championship Volunteer Orientation) to get their name badge when they first arrive at the event. Volunteers 15 and over who were not assigned roles before the event can sign up as walk-on volunteers at the Information Booth near the Registration Desk.

FIRST requires every Championship attendee to be registered and badged, including adult team mentors, youth team members, parents, family members, chaperones, etc. who are participating in the event. Attendee registration grants access to participant-only activities and increases the security of the event.

Name Badging

If you were assigned before the event, you should have received an email to RSVP for the event and register with *FIRST* Championship Registration. Completing this registration includes submitting any special dietary needs. If you registered with *FIRST* Championship Registration, please take the following steps:

- Print your personalized barcode found in the confirmation email from *FIRST* Championship Registration and bring it with you or pull up the email on your smartphone to be scanned.
- Bring a form of photo identification.
- Scan the barcode and staff will prepare your badge at the Volunteer Registration Desk.
- Any minor volunteers, ages 15-17, must bring the responsible adult who will be monitoring you to the Volunteer Registration Desk when picking up your name badge.

If you did not register with *FIRST* Championship Registration before arriving but have been assigned to a volunteer position:

- Bring a form of photo identification.
- Print your assignment email or be able to pull it up on a smartphone.
- Register and confirm your information with staff onsite at the Registration Desk on Level One to receive your name badge.

If you have not received an email from *FIRST* Championship registration but have been assigned to a volunteer position, please email <u>volunteer@firstinspires.org</u> to receive the registration email.

Consent & Release Forms

All volunteers must complete a current season FIRST Consent & Release form. Volunteers must sign the FIRST Consent & Release Form each season. Volunteers will see a notification if they haven't yet completed the form when they log into the FIRST Dashboard and can access via the profile drop down menu by selecting Acknowledgement Forms.

Walk-On Volunteers

Walk-on volunteers must be 15 years or older. QR Codes will be available for you to scan to complete a form with your availability and area(s) of interest at the Information Booth on Level One. Once the form is completed, there will be a wait time to receive your assignment if you are selected, so please be patient. Completion of the form is not a guarantee of a walk-on volunteer role. A Volunteer Coordinator will contact you by phone call or text (international numbers will be contacted by email) with assignment details. Once you are assigned a volunteer role, the Information Booth will assist you



in upgrading your credentials to 'volunteer.' Please note, volunteers 15-17 must have a parent or guardian present to complete the walk-on volunteer application process.

People interested in the Student Ambassador role should not complete the walk-on form process and should visit the Student Ambassador booth across from the Registration Desk on Level One.

NEW Metro Service to Venue

NEW! - A new Metro service is now available between the George Bush Intercontinental Airport (IAH) Terminal C with non-stop service to the George R. Brown Convention Center for only \$4.50 one way. Early Entrance

The Hilton Skybridge on Level Three opens at 5:30 AM. The Marriott Skybridge and street entrances to GRB open at 6:00 AM.

Volunteer Parking

The Volunteer parking is located at the GRB Convention Center loading dock off Chartres. Volunteer Parking passes will be emailed to volunteers by Volunteer Coordinators. **Parking is first come**, **first served**. Parking in the Volunteer lot may be limited due to construction or space limitations. This lot is reserved for volunteers only and should not include team trailers.

Drivers should enter the loading dock gates by taking a left into the open gate across from Walker St. off Chartres. A map of the parking lot for volunteers will be available in the *FIRST* Championship Volunteer Orientation presentation and in the posted slides which will be available on the Volunteer page of the Championship website.

Please note the following:

- From Monday to Saturday of Championship week the lot will be open from 5:30 AM and close at 10 PM.
- Overnight parking is not permitted.
- There is no code to enter the lot.



- There is no security. The lot is not connected to the GRB convention center. After parking, you will enter the Convention Center through a street or skybridge entrance.
- Park at your own risk.
- Your Volunteer Coordinator will email you a parking pass which is required to access the lot. Please print it in advance and make sure it is visible on your car's dashboard.
- Free parking options are limited. This lot's availability is first come, first served. Parking may fill up quickly in the morning.
- You may park in any available open spot in the lot.
- This lot is utilized by events staff and volunteers.
- Other than parking permission the pass is also important so that volunteers can circumvent the lanes being utilized by teams for the load in and load.
- Do not park along the loading docks.
- Do not park trailers in the Volunteer Parking lot, this takes additional parking spaces away from other volunteers. Trailers are NOT permitted in this lot.
- Buses are NOT permitted in this parking lot.

Special Dietary Needs

- If you have questions about ingredients or where to find various food options, please see the Volunteer Café
 Representative at the Special Dietary Needs table.
- Kosher and halal meals are not kept on the Special Dietary Needs table and only available upon request. That request needs to be submitted in your 2025 Championship Volunteer Registration (see Appendix B).
- If you did not register your request in advance, we may not be able to accommodate your request.

To help promote and recognize Gracious Professionalism at all levels, volunteers at the *FIRST* Championship will be able to give out special edition pins to individuals they see expressing Gracious Professionalism. These pins will be available for volunteers to pick up from Volunteer Central, with instructions included.

Reporting Medical Incidents and Youth Protection Concerns

If you need to report to a Youth Protection concern that is not an emergency you can report these concerns using the <u>FIRST Reporting Portal</u> or go to the nearest Pit Admin. The <u>FIRST Reporting Portal</u> can be used for any issue related to volunteering, the venue, Code of Conduct, Youth Protection, or other non-emergent safety issues. Please do not use this online form to report an urgent safety issue; follow the Emergency Procedure guidance below.

Safety and Attire

All children under the age of 12 must always be accompanied by an adult while in the Pit area.

Be aware of apparel and hair safety issues while working on your robot. Sandals, open-toed shoes, and Crocs are not allowed in the Pits, fields, or other teamwork areas. Wear relaxed, fun and appropriate clothing; remember, you represent your team and *FIRST*. Body paint in lieu of clothes, bathing suits and other revealing clothes are not appropriate.

Attire

Please dress in comfortable, appropriate attire that will allow you to carry out your volunteer role safely. Closed-toe shoes are required. We suggest choosing supportive footwear. You will be provided with a volunteer shirt and name badge to wear during your shift. Keep your name badge with you throughout the event as it is required to enter certain areas. Teams may be decked out in team uniforms or other fun attire to show their spirit. Volunteers are welcome to join in the fun and bring a silly hat or other fun accessories. Keep safety in mind and avoid dangling or loose items. All attire should reflect Gracious Professionalism.

Safety Glasses

Safety Glasses are required in some areas of the venue and for some volunteer roles. *FIRST* Robotics Competition and *FIRST* Tech Challenge programs require that everyone wear safety glasses in the pit and field areas. It is recommended



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that you bring your own safety glasses or protective side shields for prescription glasses to ensure fit, cleanliness, and ability to move freely throughout the venue.

Suspenders/Tutus Saturday

Many volunteers and team members wear suspenders or tutus on Saturday. Feel free to bring your own and take part in a *FIRST* Championship tradition!

Emergency Procedures

For urgent situations, report instantly to the nearest pit admin, *FIRST* staff member, or Volunteer Coordinator. There are medics and security onsite in the venue. They can be radioed by pit admin or staff for immediate assistance.

If the building is being evacuated, please exit the building as directed.

When there is risk of major harm:

- Medical tell pit admin, VC (Volunteer Coordinator), staff –they will radio the EMT's /Medic onsite
- Safety issue go to closest pit admin or event staff they will know who to contact.

You can read further details on FIRST Emergency procedures in this Emergency Response Document.

Health Guidelines

<u>CDC (Centers for Disease Control) guidelines</u> encourage the following preventative actions, which are also applicable to preventing the spread of many viruses:

- Stay home if feeling unwell, developing a cough, or running a fever (Call or message your Volunteer Coordinator if you need to stay home)
- Practice hand hygiene, including frequent hand washing, use of hand sanitizer, and avoiding touching eyes, nose, and mouth (there will be hand sanitizer available throughout the venue)
- Practice respiratory etiquette, including covering cough and sneezes with a tissue, and then disposing of the tissue in the trash
- Clean frequently touched surface and objects daily (including tablets and cell phones)
- Perform self-monitoring, and seek medical care immediately if feeling unwell (You can see a medic available onsite at the event)



Safety Equipment

• Bring your own safety glasses and enough masks for the duration of the event. Masks/face coverings are not required but are recommended.

Safety Outside the Venue

- Do not wear your badge outside the venue.
- Be aware of your surroundings.
- Always walk in groups.
- Use main streets and boulevards.
- Whenever possible, avoid walking downtown at night. If you cannot avoid walking downtown at night, pay
 attention, walk in a group, and get where you are going as fast as possible.

Security

Be sure to keep valuable items with you always. *FIRST* and the George R. Brown Convention Center do not guarantee security of personal items. We strongly recommend that you do not leave behind valuable items at any time, such as personal computers, cellphones, cameras, etc. You can report any lost items to the Information Booth (see Lost and Found).

Remember, the event is open to the public. Please take proper security measures to protect your valuable items.

Prohibited Items

- Abusive, foul, or disruptive language
- Aerosol containers of any kind
- Animals (except service animals to aid guests with disabilities)
- Coolers*
- Fighting, taunting, threatening remarks, gestures, or harassment of any kind
- Fireworks, firearms, and weapons of any kind (including parking lots)
- Glass containers of any kind
- · Illegal substances, drugs, and drug paraphernalia
- Knives of any length except pocketknives no longer than 4"
- Laser Pointers



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- Noisemakers (musical instruments, bullhorns, air horns, whistles, etc.)
- Outside Alcohol/Flasks
- Outside food or beverages*
- Smoking or the use of vapor (or similar) devices
- Throwing objects
- Trespassing, soliciting, peddling, and loitering
- Unauthorized/unlicensed vendors are not allowed.
- No unauthorized solicitation and materials including handbills, flyers, stickers, giveaways, samples, etc.
- Unmanned Aircraft Systems & Radio-Controlled Model Aircraft/Drones
- Any other item or action deemed dangerous or inappropriate.

Event security reserves the right to deem any other item inappropriate. No prohibited item will be accepted at the entry gates for safekeeping.


*Exceptions will be made for those with medical requirements and/or special needs. Individuals with these special needs should contact a security person at their entry gate for special attention.






Registration Step 1 - Personal Information



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
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
Registration Step 2 - Dietary Information & Meal Selection





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
Registration Step 2 - Special Events for Volunteers







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
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
