From April 25–28, teams from around the globe will be together in Detroit at the **Cobo Center**. # Hotel Accommodations and Badging

We are working with Experient Inc. for hotel accommodations and badging. **Please note – Experient receives an updated team list from our registration system every Tuesday and Thursday.** This may cause a delay in-between the time your team is registered and the time you are able to search for your team on their website to book your accommodations. # Action Required – Badging

In order to access the event, all attendees (team members, volunteers, families, and friends) must have a badge. Your team's coach must request badges for everyone traveling with your team.
