The *FIRST*® Championship is a culminating celebration for teams from <u>all *FIRST* programs</u>. From April 18 – 21, teams from around the globe will be together in Houston at the **George R. Brown Convention Center** and **Minute Maid Park** (home of the Houston Astros Major League Baseball team). Many activities are in the works to encourage teams to visit and support the other *FIRST* programs – we will share information about these activities with you in the coming weeks.

### **Schedule of Events**

## **Hotel Accommodations and Badging**

We are working with Experient Inc. for hotel accommodations and badging. Please note – Experient receives an updated team list from our registration system every Tuesday and Thursday. This may cause a delay in-between the time your team is registered and the time you are able to search for your team on their website to book your accommodations.

## **Action Required – Badging**

In order to access the event, all attendees (team members, volunteers, families, and friends) must have a badge. Your team's coach must request badges for everyone traveling with your team. These badges will be available for pickup at the Team Registration/Check-In in Houston.
